- 1) Proof of your birth date (i.e., copy of your driver's license, state identification card or passport.)
- 2) Proof of your Mill Valley residency in the form of:
 - Current Property tax bill for the residence for which you are claiming an exemption and which indicates evidence of the **Homeowners Exemption**.

AND

- One of the following items listed below:
 - ✓ PG&E
 - ✓ Marin Municipal Water District
 - ✓ Mill Valley Refuse Bill / Tam Valley Community Services District / or other local refuse agency serving residences within district boundaries
 - ✓ Comcast (cable TV) / Direct TV
 - ✓ Land line telephone (cell and long-distance service not accepted)
 - ✓ Recent homeowner's insurance document.
- 3) Pages from Trust Instrument (COPY) If ownership of your home is held under a trust instrument (TR), please submit a copy of the following pages:
 - First Page
 - Signature Page
 - Property Description: Page within your trust (Exhibit/Schedule) that references the parcel number, lot numbers for your property, or property address.

Upon receipt and verification of your information, I will notify the County Auditor to adjust the Mill Valley parcel tax assessment off your property tax bill. Your exemption will remain in effect for future years unless your primary residence changes.

- Mill Valley School Assessment (107293) the property owner must reach the age of 65 before July 1 of any given year, be an owner of record, and use the parcel as his or her principal place of residence.
- Mill Valley School Special Tax (107294) the property owner must reach the age of 65 before January 1 of any given year, be an owner of record, and use the parcel as his or her principal place of residence.

Please submit application to the District by May 1, however we do process exemptions periodically during the tax year. We cannot reimburse for past years.

The exemption shall continue for each year the applicant remains eligible during the assessment period (July 1, 1998)
