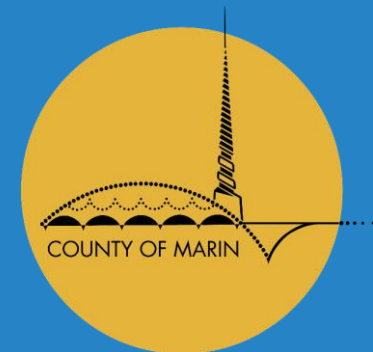
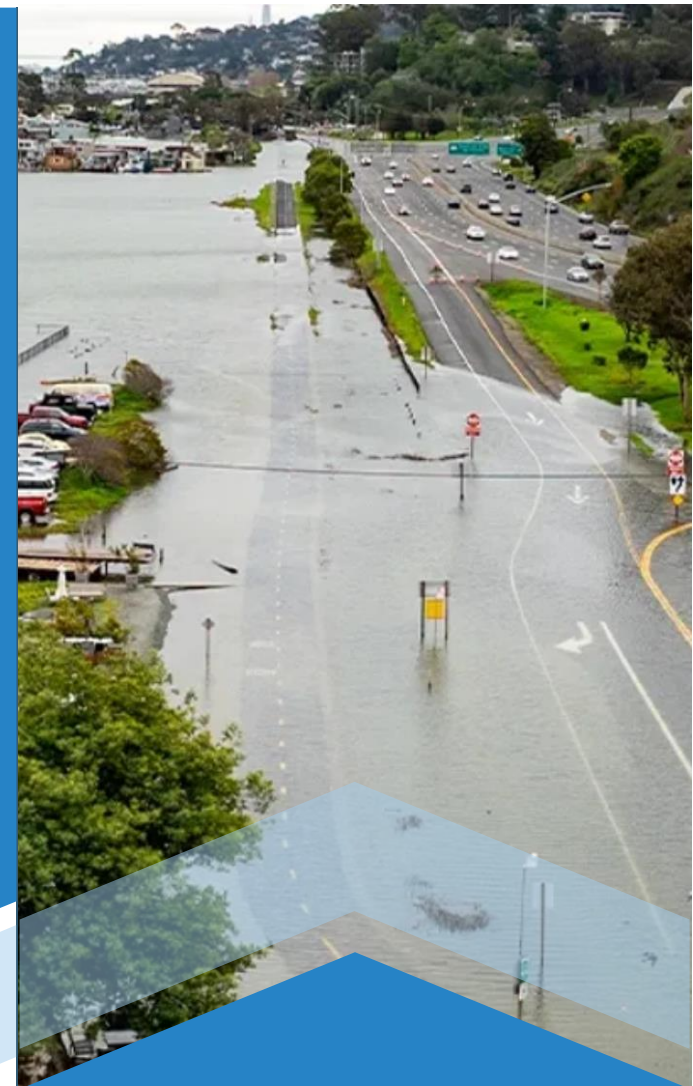

As a member of the Office of the County Executive Climate & Sustainability Sea Level Rise Team, the Climate Adaptation & Finance Strategist will help turn Marin's sea level rise plans into funded, implementable projects. The role will work across County Departments, cities and towns, special districts and community partners to develop funding and financing strategies, pursue state and federal resources, and advance coordinated climate adaptation efforts throughout Marin.

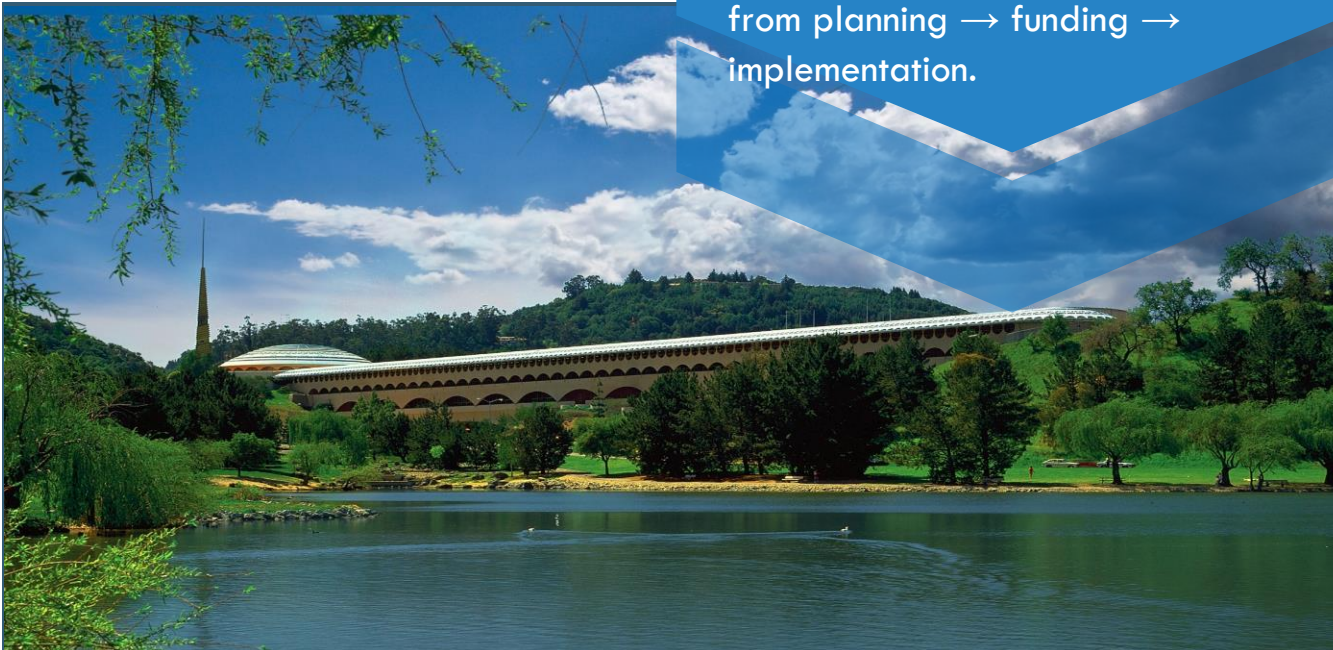
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ADDRESSING SEA LEVEL RISE IS A **TOP PRIORITY** FOR THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

With more than 70 miles of coast and 40 miles of bay shoreline, Marin is one of the Bay Area communities most exposed to sea level rise.

Adaptation needs are estimated at approximately \$17 billion, while the potential cost of inaction is estimated at \$34 billion. This position will help Marin move from planning to implementation by identifying funding and financing for priority projects.

- Explore conventional and innovative approaches, including bonds, assessment districts, special-district financing, grants, and blended public-private-philanthropic funding.
- Build and maintain a **countywide pipeline of adaptation projects**, organized by readiness. Help pursue state and federal grants for priority projects.
